
"Food and Nutrition Service Launch Online Purchasing Pilot"


Those with **SNAP** (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) benefits now have the option to order foods online with retailers **Walmart** (grocery pick up only) and **Amazon**. Although the pilot does not currently cover any delivery fees, this is a huge step forward in making nutritional food items available to everyone, including those who are unable to travel due to transportation issues or driving ability.

For Amazon Ordering:

1. Add groceries to your cart on amazon.com. At check-out click "change" in the right hand corner to bring up the payment option drop-down menu.



2. Select the "Add a new EBT card" option and enter in your EBT card information



3. Save the payment option and check normally. Once your SNAP EBT card is added to your amazon account, you'll receive free access to Prime Pantry and Amazon Fresh and free shipping on oders over \$35.





For Walmart Ordering

How Walmart Grocery Pickup SNAP/EBT Payments work:

- (1) Order: Order groceries at walmart.com/grocery or on the Walmart Grocery mobile app
- 2 Checkout: During checkout, select EBT Card as payment method
- Pickup: Swipe EBT card with the Walmart associate when you arrive at the pickup location
